**The Little Crow Solar Park Order 2022 (S.I. 2022 No. 436)– Proposed non-material change**

On behalf of INRG Solar (Little Crow) Limited (the "Applicant") please find enclosed an application for a non-material change to The Little Crow Solar Park Order 2022 (S.I. 2022 No. 436).

The enclosed application has been prepared in accordance with the Planning Act 2008, the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011<sup>1</sup> (as amended) (and references to a Regulation number in this letter are references to these Regulations) and Guidance on Changes to Development Consent Orders<sup>2</sup>.

The enclosures with this letter are:

1. An Application Statement prepared by Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP and the Pegasus Group explaining the proposal. This statement includes:
  - a) Background to the application;
  - b) The nature and materiality of the change sought;
  - c) The statement required pursuant to Regulation 7A(1) concerning publicising and the duty to consult.
2. A copy of the Regulation 6 notice, which is to be published in the Scunthorpe Telegraph on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2022 and Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2022 with a consultation response end date of Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022.
3. A draft amendment order.
4. A tracked changed version of the DCO showing the amendments sought.

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- a) The Applicant is INRG Solar (Little Crow) Limited (company registration number 11136483), whose registered offices are at 89 Leigh Road, Eastleigh, Hampshire SO50 9DQ. This entity is specified as the "undertaker" in the DCO.
- b) Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP of 115 Colmore Row, Birmingham, B3 3AL are the appointed agent.
- c) The DCO reference was EN010101 and S.I.2022/436
- d) Details of the change applied for are contained in the Application Statement.
- e) The documentation considered necessary to support the application is contained in the Application Statement.
- f) The Applicant is the entity who applied for the DCO.
- g) The statement referred to in Regulation 7A is contained within the Application Statement.
- h) The ownership interests of the Applicant in the land affected by the DCO are detailed in the enclosed Application Statement.
- i) No paper copies of the application have been requested.

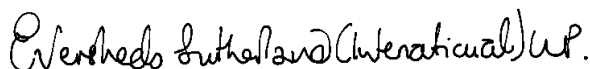
The Applicant wrote to all consultees on Tuesday 4th October 2022, advising of the submission of the application and providing them with the required details to enable them to respond. As indicated above the response deadline is Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

We can confirm that arrangements are being made for the payment of the requisite fee of £6,891.

Please note that the enclosed tracked changed version of the DCO relates to the original DCO which came into force on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022. However we would like to take this opportunity to draw to your attention that there is currently an application for a correction order before BEIS. In the event the correction order is granted then the current version of the DCO, as included with this application, will be superseded.
